PLAZA *Suite*

This Neil Simon classic is the story of three couples successively occupying a suite at the Plaza Hotel in New York. A suburban couple take the suite while their house is being painted and it turns out to be the one in which they honeymooned 23 (or was it 24?) years ago, and was yesterday the anniversary, or is it today? This cynical tale of marriage is followed by the exploits of a Hollywood producer who, after three marriages, is looking for a little “diversion.” He calls a childhood sweetheart, now a suburban housewife. Over the years she has idolized him from afar and is now more than the match he bargained for. The last couple is a mother and father fighting about the best way to get their daughter out of the bathroom and down to the ballroom where guests await her wedding ceremony. *This play contains adult situations and language.*

Plaza Suite debuted on Broadway on February 14, 1968 and ran for 1,097 performances. George C. Scott and Maureen Stapleton played the leading roles, and Neil Simon was nominated for a Tony Award for Best Play. The film adaptation was in 1971 with Walter Matthau playing the three male leads, and Carol Burnett portrayed the three female leads in the 1987 television movie.
