Coming this fall: *Dial “M” For Murder*

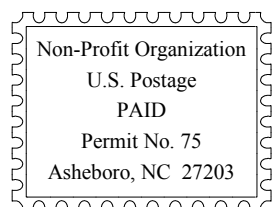
